<p>Course Description</p>	<p>This course is designed for students wanting a fast and intensive overview of sewing basics. For students entering the Pattern Making & Assembly Program and Costume, this course is critical should you not have prior knowledge or demonstrated skills in sewing.</p>

<p>Objectives</p>	<p>If you're new to sewing this is the course for you. You'll start with the basics and learn to cut and sew garments and accessories. In this 2 Day hands-on workshop, students will be immersed in hands on instruction students are taught by industry professionals in small group settings, receiving first-class learning in a real-life business environment.</p>
